Sermon Summary

- Christ was buried with haste, prior to the arrival of the Sabbath; and once the Sabbath was completed, two women sought out Jesus' tomb, to prepare His body for its final resting place, only to find it empty (Matt. 28:1-10).
- Skeptics argue...
 1. Jesus didn't really die on the cross.
 2. Jesus' tomb wasn't empty.
 3. The disciples stole Christ's body.
 4. The disciples were delusional.
- Defense for the Resurrection:
 1. In such a male-dominated climate, who would choose women as the first eyewitnesses?
 2. Why the need for a bribe?
 3. Who would reject paradise in the afterlife?
- The corrupt Jewish religious leadership used treachery to seize Jesus; they twisted the Law to have Him stand before council; they openly slandered Christ, falsely accusing Him of trumped-up charges; and now they resolved to use bribery to suppress the truth of His resurrection.
- The chief priests bought Judas' betrayal with 'blood money' (Matt. 26:15), and they planned to sweep everything under the rug with 'hush money' (28:12-13).
- If Jesus didn't rise from the grave, all believers worldwide throughout history have been following a lie, and our devotion to Him is nothing more than a waste of time.

Do YOU personally believe that close to two thousand years ago, Jesus was painfully crucified & physically died?

Do YOU additionally accept that Jesus was miraculously resurrected?

Jesus didn't die as a martyr, He died as our Saviour, and rose victorious from the grave!
