## "Gospel Witnesses" (Luke 24:36-53) Easter 2026, epilogue

### Sermon Summary

- Sometime after His resurrection, in anonymity, Jesus joined a pair of men traveling to Emmaus, seven miles from Jerusalem; and Christ interpreted Scripture for them, explaining how the recent events in Jerusalem had been foretold of, within God's Word (Luke 24:13-27).
- A risen Jesus stressed to His disciples that every part of God's written Word up to that point in history (the Law, the Prophets, and the Psalms, aka Writings), all bore witness to what would... or in this case, had already occurred (v.44-46).
- The Good News of the Gospel is not just restricted to the second half of the bible; but the Good News of Christ can be found throughout all of the entirety of Scripture.
- The Gospel of Luke exists as a record of Christ's earthly ministry; whereas Luke's second written work: 'The Acts of the Apostles,' provides for us an accounting of what the disciples did following Christ's return to heaven.
- Jesus commissioned His disciples with the open and widespread proclamation of the Good News of the Gospel; them becoming empowered with the Holy Spirit, to share with all nations of what they had experienced firsthand.
- Jesus' disciples were uniquely qualified as firsthand eyewitnesses to Jesus' death and resurrection.
- We can continue to be disciples... students of the Word... followers of Christ's commands... and messengers of the Gospel... with the ultimate goal to be disciples who make further disciples.
- We, each are gospel witnesses who are able to share firsthand of what kind of impact God's mercy and grace has had upon our individual lives, speaking to others from our own unique, personal experiences.
