"For All The People" (Luke 2:8-20) Christmas 2024: Fear Not, pt. 3

Sermon Summary

- Three times within the biblical Christmas story, an angel appears, and urges those they approached, not to fear.
- An angel first appeared to Mary, notifying her that she had been chosen to carry and give birth to God's Son (Luke 1:26-38). Next, an angel appeared to Joseph, urging him not to fear marrying Mary, for her pregnancy was the work of the Holy Spirit, not some secret boyfriend (Matt. 1:18-25).
- After Christ's birth, an angel visited a group of shepherds in a field, sharing the good news of great joy that Christ the Lord had been born nearby to them (Luke 2:8-12).
- The agriculturally-minded Egyptians originally adopted and fueled the attitude that shepherds were to be considered the 'lowest of the low,' and should tend to their flocks in the wilderness, far apart from civilized society.
- The good news that the Lord had to share wasn't reserved for the ultra-religious, but that Jesus Christ was born, was good news for all the people... even shepherds!
- Shepherds became convinced by others that they weren't either clean or good enough to draw near to the Lord.
- It is even for people whom society commonly rejects and despises, that Christ the Lord was born.
- Jesus didn't come to the earth to hang out with priests and scholars, He came to rescue the lost, to offer salvation even to the unloved.
- The good news of great joy for all people is that there is hope in God's Son, Jesus Christ, and that whoever turns to Him for salvation will find and experience eternal peace.

**Jesus Christ coming to the earth to bring
us salvation is good news for ALL people.**
