"Beware of Fake News" (2nd Thess. 2:1-12) The Letter of 2nd Thessalonians, pt. 3

Sermon Summary

- This week's passage of scripture introduces a number of difficult questions; but rather than become frustrated that we don't have all of the answers, we must faithfully trust that we serve a sovereign God Who does.
- In the beginning of 2 Thessalonians. chapter two, Paul, Silas and Timothy begin to address the 'fake news' that the Day of the Lord had already arrived, dismissing the notion that Christ's glory had been withheld from the local church.
- The Day of the Lord will not arrive until a 'man of lawlessness' has become revealed, and he launches a crusade to do evil.
- Thankfully, the 'son of destruction' is presently restrained, but he will one day be loosened upon the world, permitting him to attack both God's Law and His people.
- When Christ arrives on the promised Day of the Lord, the lawless one's evil will become eradicated with just but the breath of the Lord, the lawless one's evil brought to an end.
- Prior to Jesus' arrival however, the Anti-Christ will falsely act as Christ, performing false signs and wonders, while publicly opposing and standing against the Lord's righteousness; cruelly deceiving others to do the same.
- All those who practice lawlessness, personally refusing to accept the Lord's truth while actively denying God's grace, each become destined for eternal destruction.
- God gives His enemies over to their own sin (Rom. 1:24-25, 28); and they take delight in acting unrighteously (2 Thess. 2:12)..
- For those who reject God's love, the lie has become truth, and good has been replaced with evil; their sinful pleasures inevitably leading to their own eternal condemnation.

In every situation, seek truth, and resist following that which is most appealing to our senses.
