"Stepping Forward" (Matthew 21:12-17) Easter 2026, part two

Sermon Summary

- Jesus arrived at God's temple in Jerusalem and accused those present of turning God's 'house of prayer' into a 'den of robbers' (Matt. 21:12-13).
- None were allowed to enter into Jerusalem's temple 'proper,' but the High Priest, and only but once a year; yet there were courts that surrounded the temple designed for different groups of people to gather and worship.
- The business Jesus found conducted within the temple's outer court involved money-changing and the selling of pigeons/doves.
- Jesus was angered by: a) the vendors in the temple; b) those who purchased their wares; and especially, c) the priests who allowed such business to operate there.
- Though the blind and the lame were forbidden entrance into the area of God's temple, following His clearing of its outer court, Jesus healed them there (Matt. 21:14).
- The priests and scribes were incensed that Jesus allowed children to regard Him as Messiah (v. 15).
- Jesus further angered the religious leaders by openly expressing an authority over: a) God's temple; b) sickness and disease; and, c) all people.
- The old ritual traditions and barriers were becoming chipped away to make ready God's purpose of universal blessing for both Jew and Gentile, healthy and diseased.
- Let us cast aside our old 'sinful' self, enabling ourselves to continue to ever increasingly take steps forward as we live daily IN Christ... a NEW creation (2 Cor. 5:14-17).

In His final days of ministry, Jesus wasn't just slowly stepping towards His eventual execution; He was also laying down a proper foundation, taking the steps necessary to usher in a new gospel based upon grace.
