"Good Teaching" (Titus 2:1-10) The Letter of Titus, part three

Sermon Summary

- In contrast to the false teachers mentioned at the end of Titus chapter one; Paul's partner in ministry Titus, is to lead differently, ever teaching the Christian church in Crete what is in proper alignment with sound doctrine (2:1).
- The Apostle Paul gives wise direction to Titus regarding the church's instruction of older men and women, younger men and women, along with any bondservants and slaves within the church community too (2:2-10).
- Regardless of age, whether a man is aiming to serve the church as its leader or not, the qualifications of an elder should always be aspired towards, by all believers.
- The most important way a parent can love their children, is to share with them of a saving knowledge of Christ.
- There is no honour in prioritizing work over family; there are always plenty of different workplaces within which you can be employed, while you have but only one family.
- Submission is more about our attitude than our actions, as we aim to commit to willingly follow another person's leadership and direction.
- Titus is not just to instruct the church's younger men with his teaching, but is also expected to model for them what is involved in living a life of faith and integrity (2:7).
- All of the godly principles which Paul shares of in this letter are to be taught using the biblical model of discipleship.
- Paul instructs Titus to teach what accords with sound doctrine; so that those who are taught, might themselves openly live a life of faith and devotion that presents the gospel in a positive way to everyone around them.
