## "Be Bold" (Titus 2:11-15)

### The Letter of Titus, part four

#### Sermon Summary

- Though Paul notes that the grace of God brings salvation to all people (v. 11); he is not promoting a position that argues all people will become redeemed, but that God's offer of salvation is graciously made to all peoples.
- When Paul writes of, 'the grace of God that has appeared,' he is referencing Christ's past saving work on the cross.
- Three disciplines that all believers ought to embrace are: a) self-control (affecting ourselves internally); b) living upright (towards others); and c) godly living (due to our own personal relationship and reverence of the Lord).
- God's excellent grace not only delivers us from sin, but also teaches us to live in a way that actively leads us away from our sinful past and into His glory!
- The doctrine of salvation applies to our:
  1. Past: we are delivered from sin's penalty, (aka Justification).
  2. Present: we are delivered from sin's power, (aka Sanctification).
  3. Future: we are delivered from sin's presence, (aka Glorification).
- Christian preachers, teachers, and elders, regardless of the generation in which they live, are commissioned with the work of proclamation, encouragement, and conviction.
- When Paul writes of 'the glory that will appear' (v. 13), it is descriptive of Christ's second coming in the future.
- Being bold in our faith is not a one-time action; as we ever ought to listen boldly, respond boldly, and follow boldly; each step developing in us a greater confidence and boldness in our faith.

**Bold teaching leads to bold living and longing.**
