Sermon Summary

- When the church devotes themselves to 'doing good,' the entire community around them, believers and unbelievers alike, become blessed.
- Unrest can come from within the community itself; by individuals who might foolishly think they are being of help, but are inevitably doing more harm than good.
- By God's own design, the church is to be united, not divided; so, any action that might divide the church should be taken incredibly seriously, and not quickly dismissed.
- The goal of our confrontation with those who are doing others harm, is to call such a person to repentance, helping them to recognize how their words and actions are unnecessarily hurting others.
- Purposeful separation might initiate in divisive people a period of introspection that may result in them confessing of their sin to God, and seek restoration with their church.
- "We are not saved by faith plus works, we are saved by a faith that does work." – Daniel Akin
- The spiritual fruit borne out of our devotion to Christ involves 'doing good,' not just occasionally, but regularly - - believers doing good becoming the norm, not the exception.
- SUMMARY OF TITUS: After the grace of God appeared through the sacrificial work of His Son, Jesus Christ, all those who believe have become regenerated and renewed through the work of the Holy Spirit. This new 'birth' creating in them a new 'life,' one in which they can devote themselves to doing God's good, for the profitable benefit of everyone.

**Doing good is both excellent and profitable;
let us not defile it with selfish intentions.**
