"Good Soldiers" (2 Timothy 2:1-13) Remembrance Day Weekend

Sunday, November 10th, 2024

Sermon Summary

- While imprisoned, the Apostle Paul wrote to his partner in ministry Timothy, to give him encouragement and wisdom for the personal suffering he would inevitably face.
- Paul urges Timothy to: a) be strengthened by the grace of Christ; and b) to share the gospel with others, with the goal that those who hear it would themselves share this good news of God's grace with further others (v. 1-2).
- Paul offers that the suffering that Timothy will face, will be like that of:
 1. A soldier, who is committed to following orders, in order to please the one who enlisted them;
 2. An athlete, who exhaustively trains in preparation of a sporting competition to win a crown;
 3. A farmer, who works hard to receive the fruits of their labours.
- The common man and woman chase their own desires, while a soldier is personally committed to following orders. And while a soldier follows a superior officer, believers however are called upon to obey and serve the Lord.
- We give God pleasure, whenever we wholeheartedly obey Him, our love of God expressed through our obedience.
- In order to faithfully serve God, Timothy must become committed himself, motivated not by faithful service to his mentor Paul, but follow a faithful obedience to the Lord.
- Paul shares that he endures suffering for the sake of others' salvation, that they may receive eternal glory (v. 10).

For those who have been called to Christ, have also been tasked with a mission by Him Who has called us. A mission that involves personally sharing of the good news of the saving grace of Jesus Christ, even though we may suffer for it.
