# "The Crippling Power of Negative Thinking" (Gen. 43) The Book of Genesis, pt. 46

## Sunday, October 20th, 2024

#### **Sermon Summary**

- Their food supplies becoming depleted, Jacob ordered his sons to return to Egypt to purchase some more grain, forgetting that the governor had earlier demanded that Benjamin return with them to Egypt (Gen. 43:1-5).
- Once again, Jacob initially refused to let Benjamin go to Egypt, fearful that harm might befall him. But had Jacob possessed a bold confidence in the Lord to protect his family, he would not have hesitated for a moment.
- The popular book, 'The Power of Positive Thinking,' suggests that possessing a positive perspective can substantially improve one's life; which would also imply that a negative attitude can also be potentially crippling.
- Evangelist Church Swindoll offers three techniques we can utilize to avoid developing a negative attitude and nature:
  - 1. Recognize and admit your negative mentality.
  - 2. Force a vertical focus until it begins to flow freely.
  - 3. Stay open to a new idea, at least for five minutes.
- Only after we recognize how our own pessimistic hopelessness negatively affects our lives, can we ever hope to step out of the darkness and into the light.
- Do we thoughtlessly place a limit on the joy that God can bring our way because we lack a confident trust in Him?
- The farther we distance ourselves from the 'light,' the further we plunge into the darkness, isolating ourselves from the promising comfort and hope found in Christ.
- If we but choose to keep our spirit focused on the one true 'light,' life becomes worth living, and a spirit of negativity is choked of its power.

If one chooses to keep their eyes focused on the darkness, they'll never allow themselves to see the 'light.'
