"The Silver Cup Conspiracy" (Genesis ch. 44) The Book of Genesis, pt. 47

Sermon Summary

- Prior to the brothers leaving for home, Joseph once again instructed his steward to fill his brothers' sacks with supplies, and secretly returned to them their silver; additionally ordering his own personal silver cup be placed in Benjamin's sack (v. 1-2).
- Soon after they left, Joseph sent his steward out to catch up with his brothers and accuse them of the theft of his personal silver cup (v. 3-5).
- Found in possession of the cup, the steward demanded that the brothers return to Egypt, where Joseph insisted that Benjamin become his servant due to his guilt (v. 14-17).
- Judah didn't ask the Egyptian governor to show mercy on Benjamin, so much as he asked him to show mercy on his father, Jacob; a man in his old age (v. 18-34).
- Faced with the emotional pain that staying silent would have caused to his father, Joseph finally revealed his true identity to his brothers (Gen. 45:3).
- Are there people experiencing misery around us today that we personally have the power to end?
- Anyone who has not yet received the gift of the good news of Christ is presently suffering, largely due to the presence of sin in their lives, in the face of the absence of a Saviour.
- "I have learned now that while those who speak about one's miseries usually hurt, those who keep silent hurt more." – C.S. Lewis
- It's up to us to not only see with our eyes, but recognize with our hearts, when someone requires assistance.
